Results improve year on year

I've been a teacher at Westgate Hill Primary Academy since 2000 and have seen a number of phonics programmes implemented. Our staff and pupils love Read Write Inc. Clear behaviour expectations, calm lessons

Our staff set the highest expectations and children display excellent behaviour in phonics classes and throughout the school. The children love phonics and are aware of the expectations for every RWI lesson. They respond positively to the silent signals and know the lesson structure no matter which group they are in. Many staff use the signals in other lessons. This has created a calm teaching and learning environment.

High-quality phonics films online

The online subscription has had such a positive impact, especially when we had to provide remote learning. We can send high-quality phonics lessons to our children at the appropriate level. The online subscription has also been invaluable in the classroom for additional phonics lessons in preparation for the phonics screening check. We use it for training staff new to phonics too.

Daily tutoring, success for every child

We analyse assessment data every half-term to highlight children making slower progress who need extra one-to-one tutoring. We put in place daily support to help these children make progress.
