1. Train a reading leader in your school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>appointed a key stage 1 or reception teacher for this role</li> <li>agreed for the reading leader to attend the six-day leadership courses</li> <li>attended the first day's course with your reading leader</li> <li>agreed for the reading leader to coach the reading team during RWI lessons and lead a weekly 30-minute practice session</li> <li>met with reading tutors to analyse progress and agree next steps</li> </ul>	
2. Provide bespoke training and support in your school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>booked a phonics training and support package</li> <li>organised for all staff attend the two-day phonics training</li> <li>organised for RWI to be taught for one hour, five days a week in Year 1 and above, and 20 minutes rising to 40 minutes a day in reception</li> <li>organised for children to continue RWI until they can read with fluency – including children in later year groups who are not reading at a level commensurate with their age</li> <li>timetabled storytimes every day</li> </ul>	
3. Train tutors to ensure success for children who need the most support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>released teaching assistants to teach the slowest progress pupils for an additional 10 minutes every day</li> </ul>	
4. Introduce rigorous assessment and tracking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>organised for the reading leader to use the Online assessment to track children's reading progress every half term</li> </ul>	
5. Group children effectively to ensure maximum progress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>placed children into groups where they can make the most progress. This could mean children working in mix-aged groups</li> </ul>	
6. Use interactive strategies for the best learning behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>introduced co-operative learning behaviours in all lessons</li> </ul>	
7. Provide extensive support for parents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>organised for RWI decodable storybooks and virtual classroom links to be sent home for pupils to practise every week</li> </ul>
